Level 1 Preliminary Exam

2 Objective type exams having multiple-choice questions in OMR format.

Paper 1: General Studies

Duration: 1 hour | Total Marks: 100

Paper 2: CSAT (Civil Service Aptitude Test)

Duration: 1 hour | Total Marks: 100

NB: Paper 2 is of qualifying in nature i.e.; Candidates need to secure only 33% + marks to clear this paper. The marks secured in Paper 2 is not taken into account while preparing Mains merit list.

Level 2 Mains Exam

Those who qualify the Prelims will be able to appear in a descriptive-type examination. The exam consists of 2 papers:

General Studies Paper 1 & General Studies Paper 2

Duration of each paper: 90 minutes. Total Marks: 100 each

Level 3 Personality test (Interview)

Students shortlisted based on rank achieved in the Main Exam will be invited for the Personality test (interview). This will be similar to an actual UPSC interview. They will have an opportunity to interact with eminent Civil Servants whose guidance and right direction would boost the confidence of students.


